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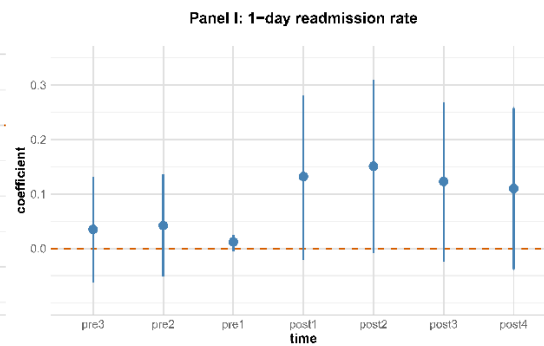
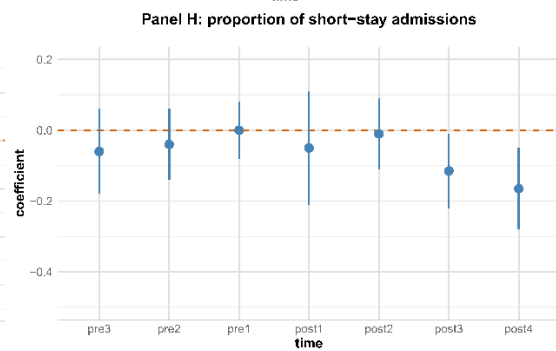
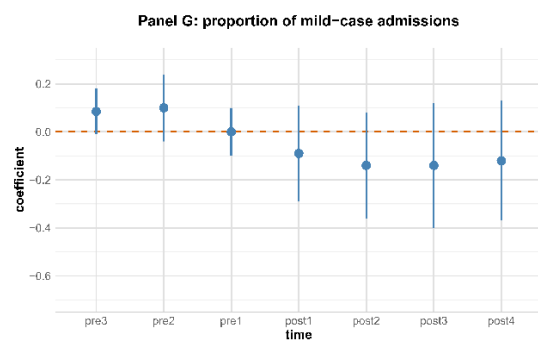
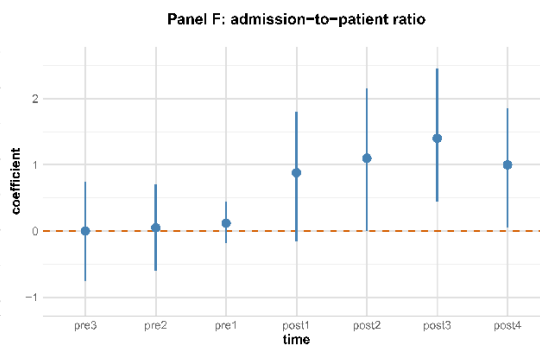
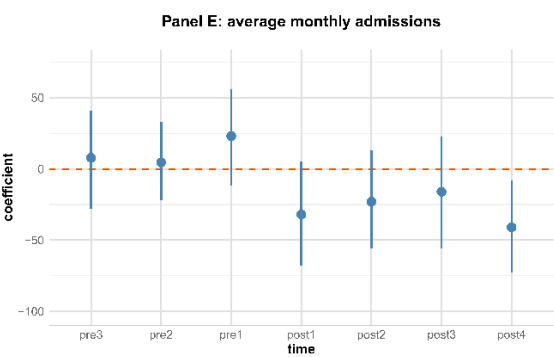
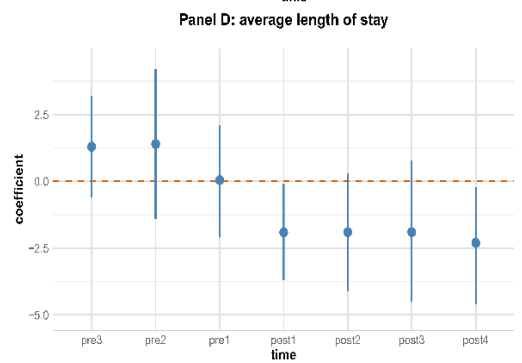
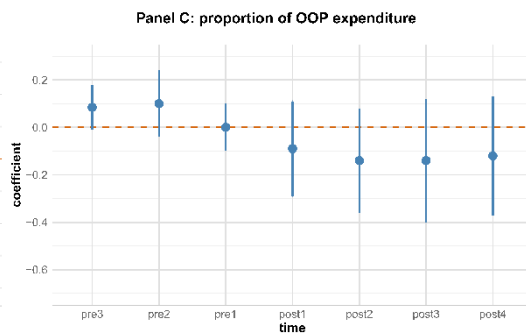
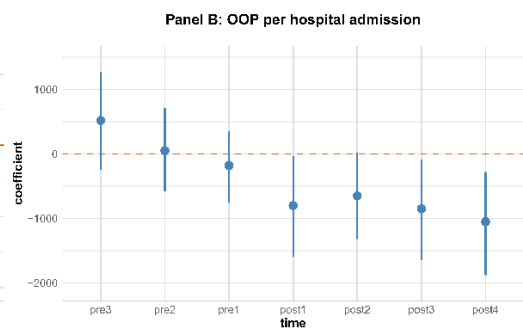
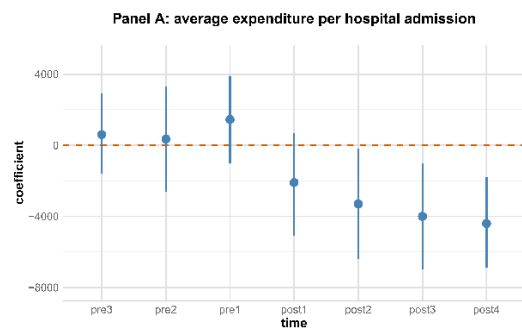

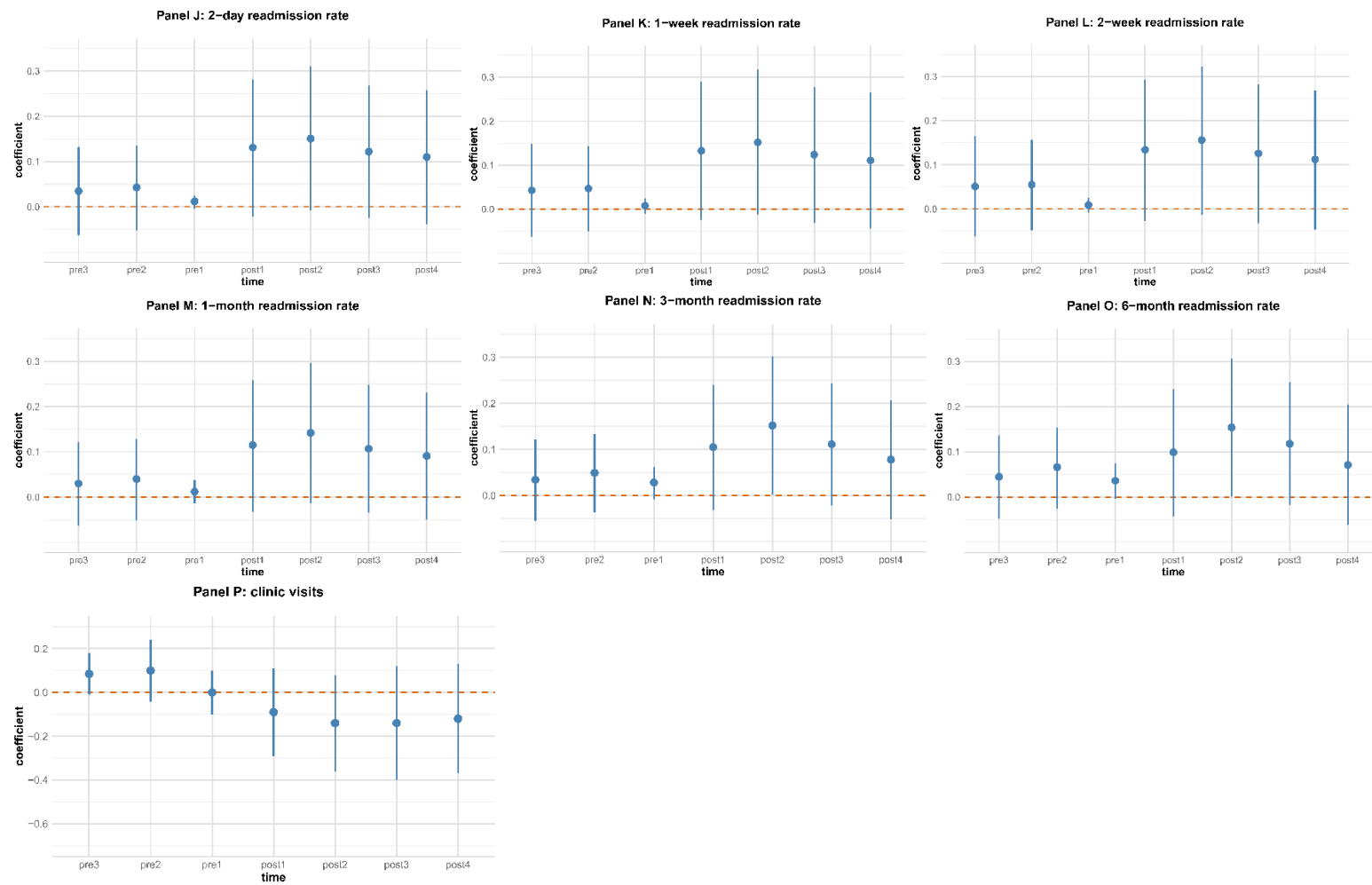


Figure S1. Tests on the validity of parallel assumptions for the whole sample.
